

**MATERIAL REVISION TO CHARTER OF  
EXTERA PUBLIC SCHOOL NO. 2**

This Material Revision to the Charter of Extera Public School No. 2 (“Material Revision”) is made between the Los Angeles Unified School District (“District” or “LAUSD”), a California public school district, and Extera Public Schools (“EPS” or “Extera”), a California non-profit public benefit corporation, *currently* operating a California public charter school known as Extera Public School No. 2 (“Charter School” and/or “EPS2”). District and EPS are also referred to collectively as “Parties.”

This Material Revision is to be read in conjunction with and shall expressly revise the charter of EPS2 which was originally authorized by the LAUSD Board of Education (“Board of Education”) on **January 15, 2013** and last renewed on November 17, 2025 for a five-year term beginning July 1, 2026 until June 30, 2031 (“Charter”).

The effective date of this Material Revision is the date of approval by the Board of Education and shall be implemented starting in the 2026-2027 academic year.

This Material Revision is *contingent* upon Charter School and/or EPS meeting all applicable requirements and procedures necessary to transfer the control, operations, governance and/or assets of EPS2 to Green Dot Public Schools (“Green Dot”) including but not limited to, the California Corporations Code and the Charter Schools Act of 1992 (the “Act”), and is based upon the following factual recitals:

**RECITALS**

A. **WHEREAS**, the approval of charter schools is governed by the Act. (Ed. Code, §§ 47600, et seq);

B. **WHEREAS**, as set forth in Education Code section 47607, material revisions of charters are governed by the standards and criteria described in Section 47605, and shall include, but not be limited to, a reasonably comprehensive description of any new requirement of charter schools enacted into law after the charter was originally granted or last renewed;

C. **WHEREAS**, the District’s Charter Schools Division (“CSD”) must determine whether the Charter, as materially revised, would be reasonably comprehensive, educationally sound, and not demonstrably unlikely to be successfully implemented;

D. **WHEREAS**, a material revision includes, but is not necessarily limited to, any change that would significantly alter a charter school's mission, vision, educational philosophy, educational program, governance, or organizational structure;

E. **WHEREAS**, as set forth in the Charter, EPS2 is authorized to serve students in grades TK through 5 and is currently governed, operated and managed by Extera Public Schools. EPS also operates another LAUSD-authorized charter school, Extera Public, serving students in grades TK through 8;

F. **WHEREAS**, Charter School’s governing board convened a meeting on January 20, 2026 and adopted a Resolution #01.26.01 (“EPS’ Resolution”) to propose materially revising the Charter to reflect changes in Charter School’s governance structure to have Charter School be governed, operated, and managed by Green Dot. The EPS’ Resolution is attached herewith as **Attachment A** and part of this Material Revision;

G. **WHEREAS**, Green Dot is a California non-profit public benefit corporation currently operating 14 (fourteen) LAUSD-authorized independent charter schools that serve students in grades 6 through 12, respectively;

H. **WHEREAS**, Green Dot’s governing board also convened a meeting on January 26, 2026 and adopted a resolution (“Green Dot’s Resolution”), citing EPS’ Resolution “desires to accept operation of [EPS2] beginning July 1, 2026” “contingent upon approval from LAUSD.” Green Dot’s Resolution is attached herewith as **Attachment B** and part of this Material Revision;

I. **WHEREAS**, changes to the governance and/or corporate structure and affiliations of a charter school constitute a material revision pursuant to California law and *LAUSD Policy and Procedures for Charter Schools* (“LAUSD Policy”);

J. **WHEREAS**, based on correspondence submitted to the District on or about January 29, 2026 (“January 2026 Correspondence”) in support of the Material Revision, the Charter School explained that: “... there would be advantages to operating as a member of a larger charter school network, for fiscal stability, to defray operational costs, and to ensure a larger portion of the annual budget is directly supporting classroom instruction and the student experience. The Extera Board and leadership have explored myriad options to ensure students continue to have access to EPS 2’s high-quality academic model. After conducting due diligence, the Board determined that having Green Dot operate and manage the Charter School would be most advantageous to EPS 2 and our students’ and that “...Green Dot has been exploring the feasibility of adding an elementary school to their network.” The January 2026 Correspondence is attached herewith as **Attachment C** and part of this Material Revision;

K. **WHEREAS**, the January 2026 Correspondence also explained that “...many EPS2 families have, for years, chosen to enroll their children in Green Dot schools such as *Ánimo Ellen Ochoa Charter Middle School* (‘*Ánimo Ellen Ochoa*’) and *Oscar de la Hoya Ánimo Charter High School*.”; and

L. **WHEREAS**, the Parties agree to materially revise the Charter to reflect the changes above, LAUSD Policy and applicable state and federal laws.

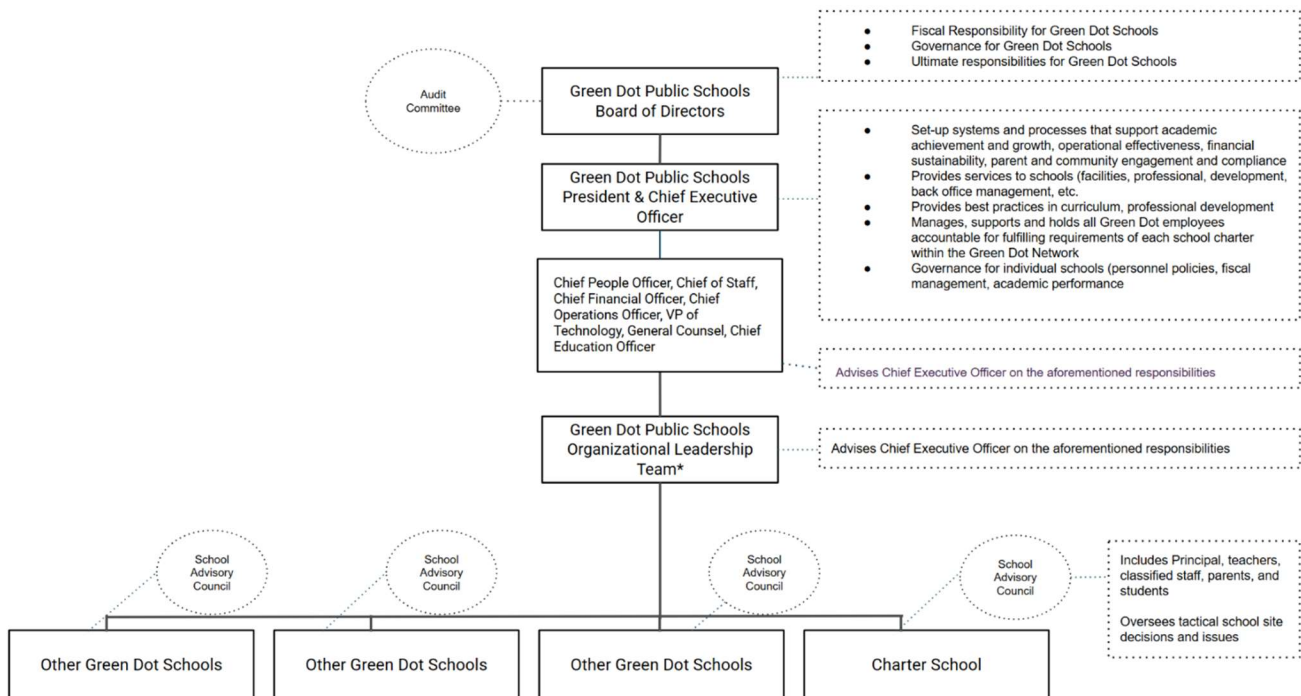
**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the following terms and conditions, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

### **MATERIAL REVISION**

1. The Parties incorporate the above Recitals as if fully restated in this Material Revision.

2. All relevant sections of the Charter shall be revised to reflect the following: Green Dot as the operating entity and governing board of Charter School, any new state and federal laws enacted and/or have taken effect since the last renewal of Charter School’s Charter, and alignment with Green Dot’s policies and procedures.

3. **Element 4 - Governance:** Element 4 of the Charter shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety to reflect that the operating entity and governing board of the Charter School as Green Dot and adapt to applicable sections in the [last approved] October 14, 2025 LAUSD Board-authorized Green Dot’s charter school, *Ánimo Ellen Ochoa Charter Middle*. In addition, the Organization Chart on page 139 of the Charter shall be deleted and replaced with the following chart below:



The Charter shall be revised to also reflect changes in staffing, some executive-level positions, their position titles, roles and responsibilities.

4. Details of the Material Revisions to the Charter, not categorized in section 2 above, are reflected in the attached revised Charter of EPS2 titled “Material Revision to Renewal [Approved] Petition submitted to the Los Angeles Unified School District Thursday, January 29, 2026”, attached herewith as **Attachment D** and incorporated as part of this Material Revision.

5. The changes made to Elements 1, 5, 8, 9, and 10 as identified in Attachment D are not considered material pursuant to LAUSD Policy. These referenced changes are identified in the 2 (two) tabs of the Table of Changes Excel spreadsheet submitted in support of this Material Revision and attached herewith as **Attachment E** and incorporated as part of this Material Revision.

6. **Budget:** All prior budgets and cash flow projections submitted for the Charter School shall be replaced by the Charter School’s revised budget(s), financial and cash flow projections incorporated and attached herewith as **Attachment F** and incorporated by reference and part of this Material Revision.

7. The Charter School warrants that it is operated by a non-profit corporation in good standing in the State of California.

8. All other provisions set forth in the Charter shall remain in effect and enforceable.

9. The Parties agree that should any of the provisions of this Material Revision be judicially determined to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

10. The Parties agree that the approval of this Material Revision shall be contingent upon Charter School and/or EPS meeting all applicable requirements and procedures necessary to transfer the ownership, control, operations, governance and/or assets of EPS2 to Green Dot including but not limited to, the California Corporations Code, and the Act.

11. The Parties agree to cooperate fully in the execution of any and all other documents and/or additional actions necessary and/or appropriate to give full force and effect to the terms, provisions, and intent of this Material Revision.

12. The individuals signing this Material Revision warrant that they are authorized to do so, and further, that they are authorized to make the promises in this Material Revision on behalf of the respective Parties.
