**NUMBER OF ROUTINE PERSONNEL ACTIONS**

This attachment addresses the total number of classified personnel actions (1,574), which entails routine personnel actions (including, but not limited to elections, promotions, transfers, leaves, terminations, separations, permits and contracts) and may be found on the Board of Education Routine Personnel Actions Report for the May 12, 2026, meeting.

The following table represents a breakdown of the new hire, reassignment, and rehire actions for the May 12, 2026, board report for the period of March 9, 2026 to March 31, 2026.

**Hire Data:**

As presented in the attached table, the total number of classified hire and reassignment actions for the period of March 9, 2026 to March 31, 2026, is 875 of which 598 (68%) are rehires or reassignments, and 277 (32%) are new hires (comprised of regular/permanent, restricted, returnee retirees, substitutes, and temporary positions). With the exception of 44 assignments, all of the actions are for positions which are school-based or provide direct support to the schools or their operations.

All new hires to regular/permanent positions are for A, B, C, or E basis positions. The 6 regular/permanent new hires consist of: Building and Grounds Worker (2), Early Education Center Attendant, IT Infrastructure Project Network Engineer, Recruitment Coordinator, Senior Resident Construction Engineer.

The following regular/permanent positions have been filled by promotional employees: Early Education Center Office Manager, Litigation Research Coordinator, Operations Program Manager (3), Special Education Assistant (2), Supervising Plumbing Inspector.
