BUDGET AND FUNDING IMPACT AND/OR CONSIDERATIONS:

The resolution as written has no budget impact. Existing program budgets will be leveraged to expand collaboration with community partners and clarify protocols for unused purchased service hours through a Districtwide bulletin.

OPERATIONAL IMPACT AND/OR CONSIDERATIONS:

Principals completing the recruitment and hiring process for PSAs and PSWs present a conflict with established HR processes, CBA, and eligibility lists. Regional and central oversight helps ensure consistency, staffing practices aligned with established HR processes and CBAs, and coordinated support for schools and students.

The proposed reimbursement language may create unintended fiscal and operational implications, as it could be interpreted as requiring direct reimbursement to schools for unserved hours. Additional clarity regarding the intent of this language would be helpful, particularly in situations involving staff absences, leaves, vacancies, or other circumstances that may impact service delivery and staffing continuity
