1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

Proposition 28 provides increased investments in Arts Education which is critical for academic growth, personal development, social emotional expression, cultural fluency, and creativity. Proposition 28 provided additional investments in arts education at 51 affiliated charter schools in the Los Angeles Unified School District. Additionally, these funds allowed us to provide additional resources to Targeted Student Populations.

During the 2024-2025 budget development period, school principals received clear guidance regarding Proposition 28 plan development, legislative requirements, and office hours for site specific budgeting assistance. This guidance included that State law requires schools to use at least 80% of funds to employ staff to provide arts instruction. This may include Elementary Arts Itinerants, Secondary Arts Teachers, Teacher Assistants, or Instructional Aides. Principals were also informed that any positions purchased with Proposition 28 funds must have job duties consistent with the respective class description. Finally, principals were informed that the remaining funds may be used for training, supplies, materials, and arts education partner programs.

Proposition 28 funds are important to our school communities because increasing arts learning opportunities and student access to arts instruction can produce significant educational benefits in a variety of areas, including academic engagement and social emotional wellbeing.
